

An open seminar will take place on **May 22 at 15.30 - 17.30** in **Aud. Ringbom, Axelia.** The seminar is arranged by Legal Psychology at Åbo Akademi (LePÅ) in collaboration with the Institute for Human Rights at Åbo Akademi as part of a lecture series on the importance of psychological expertise in legal cases.

This is the second international lecture in the series, and the key presenter will be Dr. *Tanja van Veldhuizen*, who will give a presentation on her research on interviewing and decision making practice in the EU asylum procedure.

In addition to Dr Veldhuizens lecture, current research projects concerning asylum procedures in present day Finland and led by Adjunct Professor *Julia Korkman*, Associate Professor *Jan Antfolk* (LePÅ) and Professor *Elina Pirjatanniemi* (Institute for Human Rights) will be presented.
